WHO WILL **YOU INVITE** TO HEAR THE **GOOD NEWS?**

It can bring almost any conversation to a screeching halt...and make it awkward from that moment on...until you leave...and that person never talks to you again...ever! Just kidding, they might talk to you again ... eventually. But seriously, inviting someone to Church can be hard to do. But, rest assured, it can be done. In fact, the Christmas season offers one of the more easier times to invite a friend to a service or event. Why is that? It is because even if a person isn't a regular attender to a church, they are more likely to go during Christmas or Easter to celebrate the 2 big events for Christians. In a recent poll of 1,000 Americans, LifeWay Research found six out of ten Americans typically attend church at Christmas time. But among those who don't attend church at Christmas time, a majority (57 percent), say they would likely attend if someone they knew invited them. "Regular churchgoers may assume the rest of America has already made up their mind not to attend church," said Scott McConnell, vice president of LifeWay Research. "In reality, many would welcome going to a Christmas service with someone they know."

So, how can you effectively invite a friend to Orchard Hill this Christmas season? 1. Share an invite on your social media accounts. You know, Facebook, Twitter or Instagram. Sharing an image or even writing something on your social media accounts could be a great and non-threatening way to invite someone to church. Then, when you share, you can mention that you are going and you'd love for others to join you. There are always people looking (whether they mention it on a post or not) for a church to attend during Christmas. You are simply sharing what Orchard Hill has to offer. 2. Invite them to church and then out to dinner somewhere. All of our Christmas season services will offer carols and a message of Christmas. So any Sunday in December is a great opportunity to invite someone and then go out to dinner after the service is over. (Then ask them what they thought...and simply listen.)

3. Grab some of our invites and pass them out. Whether you are out the grocery store, coffee shop, or in an office area, as you talk with others about your plans for the holidays, hand them an invite to join you. 4. Just ask. Could it be awkward? Yes. Could someone say no? Sure. But who knows, maybe they'll say yes. Pray before and ask God for the words to say and how to approach it. The reality is people tend to be open to going to church, especially during Christmas Eve. But, they don't want to go to alone where they know no one (who does, really?) So this year, ask God to show you who you should be inviting to Orchard Hill this Christmas season. From our Sunday services, to the outreach musical, to the Blue Christmas service, there are many opportunities to give away some Good News this year! -Bob Karel

A Service of Remembrance and Hope

During the God First series in November Pastor Bob preached a message, "Life God First by Being Generous". During this sermon we learned how being generous with our time and with our talents helps live a God first life, and we, also, heard how being generous with our resources is important to living this God first life. Pastor Bob showed us how the 10% tithe was the standard set in the Old Testament, when the Israelites were living under the law, and how we, who Jesus died for so we would no longer be under the law but could gain salvation by believing in him, should be even more generous. So how generous are we?




We have 189 giving units that give on consistent, regular basis. We have 234 giving units that have contributed tithes and offerings this year.

Using only the consistent, regular, tithers, this means on average each giving unit has contributed \$3,111 in tithes and offerings through the end of October. We have studies that show the average income in the Walker area in \$51,148. If we adjust this for a ten-month period, January through October, the average income would be \$42,623. Using an "average" is dangerous in some ways because we just take the amount given, divide by the number of giving units, and come up with a number. We know many people give more than the average of \$3,111, but we know, conversely, that many give less. We also know that many family's incomes are higher than \$51,000 a year while some are less. While it may not be perfect, by looking at averages we can get an idea of how generous a congregation we really are. Using the numbers above, the average giving unit is giving a tithe of 7.30%, which is well below even the Old Testament prescribed tithe. You know your situation. You know your income; you know what you give; take a moment,

look your numbers over and see if you truly are a generous giver. If not, begin to refocus and ask God to help you make the changes you need to make so you can become a cheerful, generous giver. After all, God gave his one and only Son for you!
