This month as Christians we enter into what is called the season of Lent. Historically, the church has celebrated Lent as a 40-day period beginning on Ash Wednesday and concluding the day before Easter and is marked as a time for Christians to reflect on Jesus' temptation, suffering, and death in an effort to draw closer to him. Many Christians will intentionally engage in practices that will draw them closer to Jesus. This is why a common question among Christians this time of the year is, "What are you doing for Lent?" So here is a list of 10 ideas for you to consider "doing for Lent."

1.REFLECT ON THE CROSS

Reflect daily on the power of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the meaning of his death on the cross, and the greatness of God's love for you.

2. PRAY DAILY

Set aside some extra time each day during the season of Lent for personal prayer in the morning and evenina.

3. READ THE BIBLE

Make time every day to read your Bible during Lent. One idea is to read again the entire Gospel of Mark, which has a special focus on the cross.

4. GIVE UP SOMETHING

A common practice for Lent is to give up something-like technology, social media, sweets, coffee, alcohol. etc. This is a great time to detox from things that may have a stronghold in your life. 5. START A GOOD HABIT

In addition to giving something up, try doing something good this Lent. Are you a pessimist? Try to be more positive. Are you critical by nature? Make an effort to be more encouraging. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you.

6.GIVE YOUR TIME

Give of your time by volunteering and serving as Jesus modeled for us in your church or local community. **7.KEEP A JOURNAL**

Keeping a journal of your thoughts, prayers, and reflections of the ways God is working in your life.

8. MAKE TIME FOR YOUR FAMILY

If you have kids, plan special times just for them. Take your family hiking or on a lunch date, or even have a family day where you can serve together in the community. 9.GIVE YOUR MONEY

Make a little larger sacrifice and give a little more money to your local church or consider your favorite charity or mission agency. **10. FORGIVE OTHERS**

Make things right in your life and relationships. Is there a person in your life you need to forgive? Don't hold that resentment any longer. Pray about it and ask God to help you forgive them. - Bob Karel, Head Pastor





ORCHARD HILL WILL BE PRAYING FOR LIFE!
