

Throughout our study of the book of Mark we were asked the question by Jesus, "Who do you say that I am?" The answer of Mark, and of the entire Bible, is that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God. If anyone has any doubts about this claim, this month they are all put to rest. This month we celebrate Easter and the resurrection of Jesus. The good news is that the Resurrection confirms that Jesus is who He claimed to be.

Let us consider the magnitude of this event:

-The Resurrection proved that Christ was divine. The fact that Jesus Christ died on the cross does not prove in itself He is God. Jesus proved His deity by fulfilling the prophecies of His death and by His return from the grave. The Bible declares that "by being raised from the dead [Christ] was proved to be the mighty Son of God, with the holy nature of God Himself" (Romans 1:4, The Living Bible).

-The Resurrection proved Christ's power to forgive sin. The Bible asserts, "If Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins" (1 Corinthians 15:17). By rising from the dead, Jesus proved His authority and power to break the bonds of sin and to assure forgiveness and eternal life to all who accept His gift of salvation.

- -The Resurrection revealed Christ's power over death. The Bible records, "Christ rose from the dead and will never die again. Death no longer has any power over him" (Romans 6:9, TLB). The Resurrection secured our victory over death as well and "lifted us up from the grave into glory along with Christ, where we sit with him in the heavenly realms" (Ephesians 2:6).
- -The Resurrection defeated God's enemy. From the moment of his original rebellion until the day of the Cross, the devil fought viciously and cunningly to overthrow the kingdom of God. Satan must have thought he had dealt the final and decisive blow in this age-old war. But this was the devil's most serious miscalculation. The Cross was heaven's triumph. And when Jesus Christ arose, the power of sin and death was forever shattered. Because of the Resurrection, Christians need never fear Satan or death again.

I hope you can see the resurrection is a big deal! I'm looking forward to celebrating with the Church of Jesus Christ here at Orchard Hill the fantastic life change that the resurrection brings to each of us who believe. - **Bob Karel, Head Pastor**






Guatemala Mission Team 2017

Bring either a salad or dessert (main dish, drink and table service will be provided). Message will be given by Pastor Kathy and will look at "leaving recorded memories".



caring tip

Cancer turns life upside down and brings all kinds of challenges and difficult emotions, both for the person with cancer and his or her loved ones. Those struggles and feelings can be difficult to deal with alone—or to talk about with others.

One of the most valuable gifts you can offer to someone at such a critical time is to listen in a caring, empathetic way, providing a safe, accepting space where the person can let it all out—without fear of being judged or criticized.

The book <u>Cancer—Now What?</u> (available in the Stephens Library, see Pastor Kathy) calls someone who does this a "Triple-A Friend," because such a friend will **Accept Absolutely Anything the other person** may need to share. One cancer survivor said this about her Triple-A Friend:

Once, when I was having a really rough time with my treatment, I visited with my friend and rattled off the experiences of the day. She listened to everything I had to say. By letting me voice my hurt, frustration, and fear, she helped me hold body and soul together.

How can you be a Triple-A Friend to someone you know who has cancer or who has a loved one with cancer? Here are a few suggestions:

- Give the other person your undivided attention—and show it through your eye contact, body language, and verbal responses.
- Listen, listen, listen. Ideally, you'll say very little, keeping the focus on what the other person has to say. Don't try to fix the other person's situation or tell him or her what to do. You're there to listen and care, not to solve everything.

When you encounter someone dealing with cancer—or any other difficult time in life—I encourage you to relate as a Triple-A Friend and offer the precious gift of acceptance.


