SMALL

This year at Orchard Hill we began an intentional process of shifting the nature and focus of our small röups groups. We believe that as we move forward and grow as a church, our small groups must be the place where discipleship and mission are nurtured. This is a shift in thinking as historically small groups have been seen primarily as a place for learning and connections. Traditionally, the pattern for most groups is to gather once a month, eat a snack, watch a video, talk about the content, share a few needs, and have someone close with prayer. While all of that is good to engage in, we believe we have a deeper purpose that should pull us together in groups. That purpose is to encourage and hold one another accountable in our walk of faith (discipleship) as well as serve alongside each other in bringing the Good News to our neighborhood and community (mission).

The bottom line is that we are slowly raising the bar for the commitment to and outcomes of our small groups. But we think this a bar worth raising as we call people into community to live out a greater commitment to Christ. After all, this is not a game that we're playing. This is not just a hobby that you have. Christianity demands all of your life. Christian discipleship does mean surrendering your life and ordering your life differently than the world. Currently much of what we do in the church actually caters to consumerism rather than challenges Christians to be self-feeders of God's word, self-leaders in discipleship, and self-multipliers in making and multiplying disciples. So, we are striving to create a structure that will halt the consumerism and help people live out the call placed on our lives. Typically, traditional small groups more often than not are centered on meeting a particular need which just caters to our consumerism. Our time in our group never challenges people to obey in a different fashion. Instead, they often just create and perpetuate consumerism: whether it's a specific Bible study, a community of people that are like you, or a particular need that you have to fill. Our goal is to challenge people to self-lead, self-feed, and self-multiply. The goal we set for this past year was to have each of our groups identify a collective mission that they could move forward together. The good news is that most groups were receptive to this vision and we now see a host of Orchard Hill people being the hands and feet of Jesus in a variety of ways from supporting struggling single moms to feeding those who are under resourced. As we continue to serve in this way we bring a Christ-like presence into our world transforming it to look more like the Kingdom of God. We have also started gathering all of our group leaders together on a quarterly basis to encourage, equip, and provide our leaders with the **RAISE BAR** resources to help us live into this new direction we are moving. The meetings we have had together have been rich and rewarding times and we look forward to these leaders raising the bar of discipleship and mission in their small groups.

If you are connected in a small group, we want to encourage you to consider how you can prioritize and make room to do life in a greater capacity alongside and with your brothers and sisters in Christ. 

Caring for People...Caring for Self Lament

What is lament? We sure don't use this term very much in the church or in society today, but lament is the simple act of praying our grief to God. Yes, God wants to hear our grief as well as our joy. We find lament in many of the Psalms like, 8,16,40 and 84. We find lament in the book of Job and 1 Samuel. Lament is a sharing of our feelings, grief, anger, and questions that we may have with the Almighty.

You know all those questions we have of how long, and why, and where are you God? God wants to hear and God wants to answer. God doesn't say "Get over it" to the problem or issue. He says "Give it to me". In difficult times we have a choice to make; we can choose to lament in God's direction, or turn away from Him. He wants us in relationship to share all that we are. Lament is an offering that we give to God just as joy, praise, and adoration are also offerings.

Jesus lamented before the Father. Remember the garden when Jesus cried out for the Father to take the burden from him? Remember the cross as Jesus cried out in thirst and pain? Remember Jesus as he cried for the death of his friend Lazarus? Jesus knew lament and shared the pain and grief with the Father, because they were in relationship together. We too because of our relationship through Christ can share our grief and our pain with the Father, calling out to him our questions, our sorrows, and our pain. Rediscover the art of lament. Rediscover a deeper relationship with God!
