
THIS MONTH WE CELEBRATE THE 500TH BIRTHDAY OF THE REFORMATION.

The Reformation was a 16th century widespread theological revolt in Europe against the abuses and totalitarian control of the Roman Catholic Church. Reformers such as Martin Luther in Germany, Ulrich Zwingli in Switzerland, and John Calvin in

protested various unbiblical practices of the Catholic Church and promoted a return to sound biblical doctrine. On Sunday, October 29 we kick-off a 5 week series looking at the five pillars of faith that were at the heart of the Reformers' call for the church to return to biblical teaching. 
