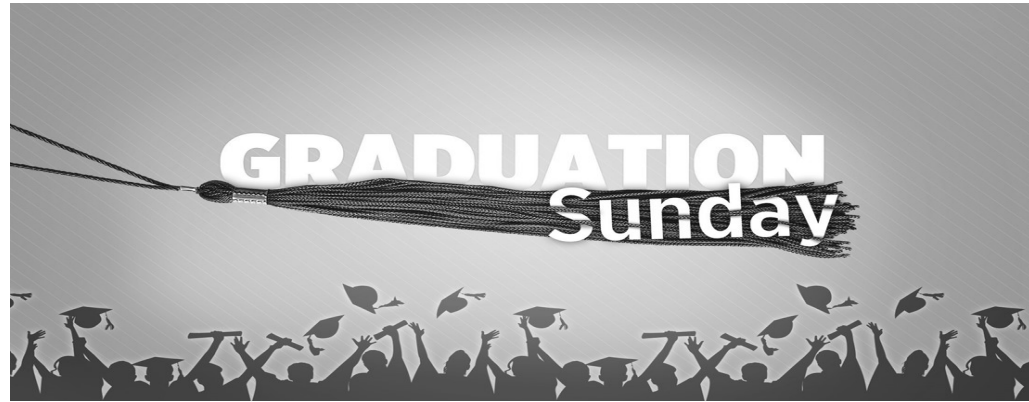


WORSHIP
