

Read Mark 1. Discussion Questions:

1. How did Jesus' miracles show His care for creation?
 - a. Jesus' miracles restored parts of creation that were affected by sin coming into the world. He cast out unclean spirits, made sick people well, and healed skin diseases. Later in His ministry, He raised people from the dead, gave sight to people who were blind, and ultimately brought the greatest healing—the forgiveness of sins—through His death and resurrection.
 - b. Read Psalm 77:14.
2. Do we need to see miracles to believe in Jesus? Why or why not?
 - a. Many people saw Jesus' miracles and believed, but Jesus said those who do not see and still believe are blessed! The Bible tells us everything we need to believe in Jesus.
 - b. Read John 20:29-31.
3. In what ways does God reveal Himself today?
 - a. The Bible
 - b. Creation
 - c. Prayer
 - d. Relationships with family and friends
 - e. Read Romans 1:19-20.
