

Discussion Questions:

1. What is living water? Where does it come from?
 - a. Jesus offered living water to the Samaritan woman. He was talking about the Holy Spirit. Jesus gives the Holy Spirit to those who trust Him. He saves us from our sins and gives us eternal life.
 - b. Read John 7:37-39
2. Why is sharing your testimony important?
 - a. There is power in the Samaritan woman's testimony. She told others in her town about what Jesus had done, and they believed in Him! Everyone can tell others what God has done in his or her life. Jesus calls us to build relationships with other people and tell them about Jesus!
 - b. Read 1 John 4:13-15
3. What are some ways you can show love to others? How can you remember to put others first?
 - a. Allow kids to share their ideas. Suggest kids paint a fingernail a bright color or wear a special bracelet that they will see frequently that will remind them to have an others-first attitude.
