

Discussion Questions:

1. How was Jesus able to feed the crowd with just five loaves of bread and two fish?
 - a. Jesus feeding the crowd was a miracle! God took care of the Israelites in the desert by giving them manna. When the people saw this sign, many believed that Jesus was the Prophet whom God had promised to send.
 - b. Read Matthew 6:33
2. What did Jesus mean when He said He is “the bread of life”?
 - a. Bread satisfies the body, Jesus satisfies the soul. Only Jesus is able to satisfy our souls forever by providing forgiveness, peace with God, and eternal life. The eternal life that Jesus provides is better than bread that temporarily satisfies our bodies.
 - b. Read John 6:27
3. How has Jesus recently provided for some of your needs, spiritually or physically?
 - a. Allow your kids to share how God has provided for their needs. Remind them that every good gift comes from God. He provided for us in the greatest way by sending His Son to give life to the world.
