

Discussion Questions:

1. What do you think the disciples realized about Jesus after they saw Him changed?
 - a. This event made the disciples understand even more that Jesus really was the Son of God! Remember what God said to Jesus at His baptism? Read Mark 1:11. Even though Jesus would rise from the dead, the disciples didn't really understand what he meant yet.
 - b. Read Mark 9:10
2. How is Jesus greater than Moses and Elijah?
 - a. Moses had seen a glimpse of God's glory. After, Moses reflected God's glory in his face (Exodus 34). Elijah told people about God's glory (1 Kings 18). Jesus showed God's glory directly and brings us into God's presence.
 - b. Read Hebrews 3:3-6
3. Why should we listen to Jesus?
 - a. At Jesus' transfiguration, a voice said, "This is My beloved Son... Listen to Him!" Jesus is God in the flesh. We listen by submitting to Him as the king of our lives. We listen to what He tells us through His word and we obey Him.
 - b. Read John 14:23.
