## Read Matthew 22, Mark 12, and/or Luke 20

## **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. Why did the religious leaders ask Jesus questions? Were they really interested in what Jesus was teaching?
  - a. The religious leaders were only asking questions to try and catch Him doing something wrong. Jesus knew what they were trying to do and answered them with wisdom and authority.
  - b. Read Luke 20:22-26
- 2. How can we see Jesus' wisdom and authority in the way He answered the religious leaders?
  - a. The religious leaders thought that they had come up with a question that would trap Jesus when they chose to ask Him about taxes. They thought that either way He answered, the Jews or the Romans would have a problem with it. But, Jesus saw beyond their craftiness and answered with wisdom and power.
  - b. Read Luke 20:25
- 3. How can we answer life's questions with wisdom?
  - a. We can find answers to life's questions as we spend time with the Lord through prayer and reading His Word. When we hide God's Word in our heart, we too can answer with wisdom.
  - b. Psalm 119:105.
