

Read Matthew 26, Mark 14, Luke 23, and/or John 13

Discussion Questions:

1. Why did Jesus allow His enemies to arrest Him?
  - a. Jesus could have chosen not to be arrested. He could have stopped it from happening! But, He willingly let it happen out of obedience to God the Father and His love for us.
2. Caiaphas asked Jesus if He was the Messiah. What does Messiah mean?
  - a. It means the anointed one, or the promised deliverer, or savior.
3. Jesus laid down His life for us. How can we lay our lives down for others?
  - a. Discuss the kids ideas. Also remind them that we can lay down our lives for others by making choices to place others before ourselves.
