

Read Luke 24.

Discussion Questions:

1. What were the two disciples talking about as they walked? Why were they upset?
 - a. The disciples were sad about Jesus' death. All of Jerusalem had witnessed Jesus' triumphal entry and the His death on the cross. His disciples had scattered when He was arrested, but the two disciples travelling had heard rumors that May and the other women had seen Jesus alive. They didn't know what to believe!
 - b. Read Luke 24:6-7.
2. How is the Bible all about Jesus?
 - a. Jesus coming to earth was God's plan all along. Adam and Eve sinned, and God already had made His plan to send Jesus to rescue people from sin. The Old Testament points to Jesus' life, death, and resurrection. This is the time when Jesus would bring God's salvation to the world!
 - b. Read Genesis 3:15.
3. How do you think the disciples must have felt to finally realize the person they saw was Jesus?
 - a. Allow the kids to share their thoughts. Compare the disciples recognition of Jesus to the transformation we might experience when we trust in Him for salvation. When Jesus saves us, He brings light into our dark lives. We were dead in sin, but He makes us alive!
 - b. Read John 5:24.
