

Read Matthew 28 and/or Acts 1.

Discussion Questions:

1. What is the Great Commission?
 - a. Jesus went to heaven, and He is going to come back someday! While we wait, Jesus gave us a job to do. Jesus wants us to help more people follow Him. The Great Commission is Jesus' command for His disciples (and us!) to go preach the gospel to everyone.
 - b. Read 2 Peter 3:9.
2. Why is obeying the Great Commission so important?
 - a. Because other people before us obeyed this command, we heard the story of Jesus and have had the chance to believe ourselves. Jesus wants to continue the sharing of the gospel for more people to have the chance to believe because Jesus wants everyone to be in heaven!
 - b. Read Romans 10:14.
3. How does the Great Commission apply to us?
 - a. The Great Commission wasn't just a command for Jesus' disciples. It was a command for everyone who believes in Him. Everyone needs to hear this good news, because we all make mistakes and disobey God's commands. God calls some people to go to far away places to share the gospel with people in other countries. Sometimes, God calls people to stay where they are and share the gospel with the people around them. Wherever you are, you can and should share the gospel!
 - b. Read Romans 1:16.
