

Read Matthew 28 and/or John 20.

Discussion Questions:

1. What did Jesus' resurrection prove about His death on the cross?
 - a. Jesus died to pay the penalty for our sins. He took the punishment we deserve. God's raising Jesus from the dead proves that his payment for sins was sufficient and final.
 - b. Read Hebrews 10:10.
2. How does Jesus' resurrection give us hope for our own resurrection?
 - a. Though our bodies may die on earth, we will live with God forever! When Jesus returns, believers who have died will be raised and all believers will receive new, transformed bodies that will never die.
 - b. Read 1 Corinthians 15:51-52.
3. How should we respond to Jesus' healing us through the forgiveness of sins?
 - a. The more we understand Jesus' forgiveness, the more our love for Him grows. Because Jesus died for us, we live for Him.
 - b. Read Luke 7:47.
