GENEROSITY/FINANCES

As we navigate through this season of COVID-19, unfortunately we are continuing to see a drop off in general fund giving. We have been especially hit hard the last 2 weeks with no in-person worship. Through the first 22 weeks of this budget year we are \$10,665, or \$485/week, behind budget (-4%). The weeks prior to COVID-19 we had an average of 89 giving units contributing to our finances, while in the weeks following COVID-19 we have only averaged 65 giving units.

We want to encourage everyone to faithfully support the ministry and work of your church family. The ministry of Orchard Hill has not lessened any because of the Corona Virus. If anything, it has created more opportunities and need for ministry as we strive to serve those hit hardest by this pandemic.
