2. Download and install

  - b. Don’t allow access and search for our church manually
5. Click on our church logo and select, ‘This is my church’
6. Enter your mobile phone number
7. Enter the login code that will be immediately texted to you
8. Click on your user profile to log in

#### Open in web browser:

1. Go to [orchardhill.org](http://orchardhill.org) and click on the “Connect” tab
2. From the drop-down menu, click on “Church Center”
3. Click on “log-in” and add your cell number or email
4. Follow the prompts to complete the log-in process
