Day 2: 1 Timothy 6:6-10

- 2. Notice that money is not the root of all evil, but the "love of money" is. In what ways can the love of money be the root of all types of evil?

Day 3: Hebrews 13:5

- 1. What are some things in the world that stop you from being content with what you have?
- 2. What does this verse say should give us ultimate contentment?
- 3. Are you fully satisfied in God or do you search for other things to bring you contentment? If so, what things do you need to guard your heart from?

Day 4: Matthew 6:19-24

- 1. Why can money be a distraction from your service to God?
- 2. Is money a distraction from your relationship with God?
- 3. How is Jesus' instructions on money management different than our worlds?

Day 5: Acts 4:32-35

- 1. This passage describes how the early church functioned. How did these Christians view their own possessions?
- 2. What was the result of their generosity?
- 3. Were these Christians more interested in building their own kingdom, or building God's kingdom here on earth?
- 4. How can this church be an example for you today?
