Church Center is the new and easy to use virtual portal for our church family. On Church Center, you will be able to sign up for groups, register for upcoming events, and access the Church Directory.

Last January, we introduced you to Church Center with the hope of our church family using it in multiple ways. If you have an email address on file with us, you would have received an invitation to join.

We are starting to promote Church Center again for those of you who do not have it. Our goal is to have everyone who is a member or regular attender join so we have an up-dated directory. A couple of advantages to this are that you can include as much information as you feel comfortable giving and you can also change your information at any time (this also changes the information in our church database. So if you move, you can change your address with the church on the app).

TWO WAYS TO JOIN:

Download and install the app:

- 1. Search 'Church Center' in your app store
- 2. Download and install
- 3. Click on 'Get Started'
- 4. It will need to find our church so you can either:
 - a. Allow it to access your location & click Orchard Hill Church
 - b. Don't allow access and search for our church manually
- 5. Click on our church logo and select, 'This is my church'
- 6. Enter your mobile phone number
- 7. Enter the login code that will be immediately texted to you
- 8. Click on your user profile to log in

Open in web browser:

- 1. Go to orchardhill.org and click on the "Connect" tab
- 2. From the drop-down menu, click on "Church Center"
- 3. Click on "log-in" and add your cell number or email
- 4. Follow the prompts to complete the log-in process
