OHC AND THE RCA

The long-awaited Vision 2020 report finally came to General Synod 2021 this October. Unfortunately, the report did little to address the division that has developed in the RCA over the past four decades. Over the course of these years, the RCA has spent a lot of time in discussion and discernment over the issue of sexuality and marriage. While the RCA has never voted to leave the historical and orthodox interpretation of scripture, in practice, more and more RCA Pastors, Churches and the RCA Seminaries are turning their back on that stance and are operating in a contrary way. Because the governmental structure of the RCA does not allow for there to be correction brought to these Pastors, Churches and the Seminaries, the drift away from the clear Biblical teaching of God's word is continuing. This drift towards a revisionist and progressive view of God's Word is an untenable position for those who hold to the unchanging authority of God's Word. During the last forty years, countless number of conversations and proposals have been made to bring the RCA back into alignment with God's Word, but all efforts have failed. As a result, the Vision 2020 Team was organized to provide a way forward for the denomination. The report unfortunately failed to address the core issues around Biblical authority. What was offered are regulations for mutually generous separation when churches choose to leave the RCA to pursue new connections that will honor the integrity of God's Word and allow for mutual ministry to take place. Given this situation, Orchard Hill Church leadership has formed a team to begin exploring the possibility of leaving the RCA. There are a multitude of issues involved with a decision of this magnitude and as the team processes through them, we will keep our church family up-to-date. Please be in prayer for this team and our decisions as a church.

Pastors Bob and Laura will be hosting a brief conversation about this process in the sanctuary on Sunday, December 5 following the morning service for those interested.


CHURCH PROPERTY

Over the past few years we have considered a number of opportunities that have been brought our way regarding how to best use the resource of 42 acres on our corner that God has entrusted to us. Some of those opportunities have been to offer our land as a hub for ministry development within our community, while others were to simply sell a portion of the land to developers and then use the money to advance our ministry priorities at Orchard Hill. As these options have been considered, what became apparent is that OHC needs to seek God's clear leading on how we can best utilize the land for His kingdom. In that regard, our leadership has decided to spend the next six months in a season of discernment. We envision this season to be both a time of individual and communal prayer. Our hope is, at the end of this season, we would have a clear sense of God's leading to either sell a portion of the property or to retain the property for cooperative ministry development.
