TODAY'S SERVICE - IN-PERSON AND ONLINE

Today, Pastor Bob continues with the series titled "Breaking Barriers". This series starts us on our path towards Easter as we look at several characters from the book of John. The scripture for this week's message is John 20:24-28 and can be found on page 1687 in the pew Bible.

During the season of Lent, we have committed to memorizing the Apostles' Creed. Copies can be found on the Ministry Highlights table in the lobby.

Apostle's Creed clarification: Why do we say "holy catholic church" in the Apostles' Creed? The term "catholic" (lower case "c") does not refer to any specific denomination or group of Christians. The term comes from two Greek words that together mean "throughout the whole." This single word, "catholic," means throughout all time and places and also points to the essential unity or wholeness of the church in Christ. No one English term captures that dual sense of this ancient Greek term quite as well as "catholic." So when the creed states, "I believe in the holy catholic church," it refers to the wholeness of the whole church in all times and places rather than to any specific branch of Christianity.

As our Governing Board continues to seek your input from our time of prayer and discernment regarding our property, you are invited to speak with Dan Heitzman in the lobby after the service.
