OHC PROPERTY UPDATE

We as the OHC Governing Board want to thank you for your support, consideration, conversations, and prayers regarding our time of discernment over the usage of our church property. As we have come to the end of this reflection time, one thing that has become evident is that everyone desires to see that the property is used well for the Kingdom of God. Our collective hopes and desires have leaned into the parable of the Good Stewards and expressed a firm conviction that we cannot sit by and leave our land vacant for another thirty years. We all desire to see it used to bear fruit for the Kingdom.

What this usage looks like is yet to be determined. We think the best next step forward is to engage with a planner to establish the broad stroke parameters of what areas of land can be developed, what type of developments are possible on the land, and what developments the City of Walker would support. Having a clear picture of what is possible on the site will help formulate possible directions.

At the same time, we believe it may make some sense to gather a group of ministries that have expressed some interest in possibly utilizing our land and discern if the collective efforts of this group have the resources to develop the land into a ministry hub. This type of collective project has been talked about numerous times and we believe we should put some effort in to see if this direction could be a reality.

If this effort fails to gain traction, then perhaps we can think about offering our land for sale to a ministry that we endorse and would like to be invested with on the land. At the very end, if all else fails, at any time we can work with a commercial realtor to market our land and sell it out right and then use those funds to support and develop a variety of ministries.

We believe time is on our side. We do not have to make a hasty, rash, or ill-informed decision. With the Get 'er Done Campaign entering the final stages and a relatively healthy bottom line we do not need to react to financial pressures to make an urgent sale happen. As you can tell from this writing there is still a lot to discern and figure out, but that is where God comes in. This is His land and we are offering it for His work; therefore we are confident God will make a way for a vibrant and robust ministry to occur off of Bristol Ave. As stated, that ministry will not come to light if we continue to do nothing. As faithful stewards of what God has entrusted to us we are committed to taking thoughtful steps so that this 46 acres of land will shine even brighter as a light on the hill!
