BUILDING MAINTAINENCE

We have had to respond to an immediate need to upgrade the controls for our heating and cooling systems. Our present controls are outdated and as parts break replacing them is no longer an option. The Andy Egan Co. has been contracted to replace our control system at a very generous price of \$150,000. Work has begun and will take a few months to complete resulting in a more cost and energy efficient system.

DENOMINATIONAL CHANGE

The North Grand Rapids Classis Executive Committee received and began processing Orchard Hill's petition to withdraw from the RCA. There was a general agreement within the Executive Committee to complete this process in good order and within a shorter period of time than suggested by the BCO. It is the intent of the Executive Committee to vote on the petition at the September 20, 2022 meeting at the very latest. This means that Orchard Hill will gather for a Congregational Meeting and vote in mid-August.
