GIT 'ER DONE CAMPAIGN

Git 'Er Done is our 3-year campaign to eliminate our building debt. This campaign started in November 2019 and will end this November. The good news is that \$824,265 has been given towards reaching our goal of \$910,000! The generosity of our OHC family has been great! We want to encourage everyone to finish strong, honor their pledges, and continue to give generously over these last four months. If everyone follows through on their pledges, we will exceed our goal and raise \$966,371! How awesome would that be! The outlook currently, however, is that we are on pace to finish the campaign with \$872,285. This would be a \$37,735 shortfall. The end is in sight OHC! Let's Git 'Er Done, so that our eager willingness to do it may be matched by our completion of it, according to our means (2 Corinthians 8:11).

CONGREGATIONAL VOTE

On August 14, the North Grand Rapids Classis conducted a meeting of the Orchard Hill Church membership in response to our request to leave the Reformed Church in America (RCA) and join the Alliance of Reformed Churches (ARC). Two hundred eleven (211) OHC members were present at that meeting and the motion passed with 187 voting in favor (89%) while 23 members voted against the motion. The next step is for the North Grand Rapids Classis to respond to our request at their September 27 meeting. Thank you to everyone who attended and participated in this important decision in the life of our church.
