ADULT MINISTRY

Growing as disciples by walking alongside one another.

Mentor

Serve as a spiritual mentor for another adult seeking to grow as a disciple of Jesus.

Group Leader

Create and/or lead a small or mid-sized group in an environment where people can pursue authentic community and spiritual growth.

Men's Ministry Team

Help plan a variety of events and activities to encourage men to grow in their faith and friendships.

Women's Ministry Team

Help plan a variety of events and activities to encourage women to grow in their faith and friendships.

Young Adult Ministry Team

Bring a meal for hungry Flock members (ages 18-30) at their weekly Thursday night gathering, or serve as a mentor to a young adult.

Stephen Ministries

These volunteers receive 40 hours of training, as they prepare to walk one-on-one with someone in crisis. Commitment is two hours, once a week, for two years.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Investing in children by showing up in their world.

Welcome Desk Leader

Give an excellent first impression of Orchard Hill to families. Welcome, register, answer questions, and offer information to parents.

Nursery Caregiver

Provide excellent care for babies and toddlers (ages newborn through 2 years old) in a secure environment, as you connect relationally with their families so parents can participate in worship.

Preschool Leader and Co-Leader

Connect relationally with preschoolers (ages 2 to 4 years old) and their families. Help oversee preschool worship and implement classroom activities that foster the spiritual growth of children. Curriculum and supplies are provided by the Children's Ministry Director.

HillKids Small Group Leader and Co-Leader

Develop relationships with children (Kindergarten through 5th grade) while leading in-class activities based on the Bible story taught in large group. Curriculum and supplies are provided by the Children's Ministry Director.

Arts Camp

A variety of positions needed for one week in the summer. There are positions for small group leader, elective class teachers, worship team, snack crew, greeters, and more!

CHURCH MANAGEMENT

Enabling the ministry of the church to run smoothly.

Office Volunteer

Occasions arise when Orchard Hill's office has projects that benefit from additional sets of hands. These include a variety of tasks and other administrative duties.

Technology

Computer savvy people are needed to keep our IT systems running smoothly.

Website and Marketing

Help Orchard Hill get its name out in the Community! Assist with designing marketing tools and keeping the website up-to-date.

Building and Grounds

Orchard Hill has a large facility and it seems our to-do list never ends. If you are skilled in any kind of maintenance or handiwork, we'd love for you to join our team! Use your mechanical, electrical, plumbing, gardening, and other special skills to help maintain our church building and grounds.

Photographers and Videographers

Help us capture great images and videos of our events and ministries! We are looking for experienced volunteers that can serve when needed, to help capture the life and energy of Orchard Hill.

HOSPITALITY MINISTRY

Making it simple for guests to engage in church life and mission.

FRONTLINES TEAM

Greeter Team

Provide a positive interaction to every guest and offer assistance as needed. Commitment is once every six weeks, prior to Sunday worship.

Ushers Team

Provide a positive impression to our guest walking into worship and help collect Sunday offerings. Commitment is once every six weeks, prior to and during Sunday worship.

Connection Corner

Personally connect with guests to facilitate their best next steps. Commitment is once every six weeks prior to and after Sunday worship.

Security/Parking Attendants

Keep our staff/members safe during worship services. Help navigate parking during special events.

SUNDAY CARE TEAM

Sunday Morning Coffee Servers

Work with hospitality coordinator to provide coffee and goodies for guests, prior to and after Sunday worship.

Sunday Prayer Ministry

Gathers together on Sunday with the Frontlines and Sunday Care Team for prayer before the service to pray over the volunteers and the Worship Service.

Online Host

Help welcome and interact with viewers as our online service is streamed on Sunday mornings. Commitment is 1-2 times a month during Sunday worship.

HOSPITALITY MINISTRY cont.

SPECIAL EVENTS CARE TEAM

Congregational Care Team

Help plan and execute events at Orchard Hill, such as Blue Christmas, Christmas cards for shut-ins, encouragement cards for college students, and serving goodies at outreach events. This team serves behind the scenes to deliver care in many ways.

Meals Ministry

Prepare and deliver meals to those in need due to medical issues, on an as needed basis.

Funeral Hosts

Funerals are a part of life and often take place at Orchard Hill. Volunteers are needed to assist with funeral receptions, hospitality, and other behind the scenes needs to support the family and friends of the deceased in their time of grief.

Prayer Shawl Ministry

Our prayer shawl ministry shows the love of God to those who are weary, who may be suffering or in pain. Each shawl that is made is prayed over while it is being made.

Special Events Team

This team works with the events coordinator to plan and serve for special events and dinners for the Orchard Hill family.

OUTREACH

Making a real life impact on our city, in the name of Jesus.

Kids' Hope at Central Elementary

Serve as a mentor, 1 hour a week, to a student in need of help and encouragement, or serve as a prayer partner.

Safe Families for Children Team

Partner with local parents in crisis through Bethany Christian Services by temporarily hosting their children in your home or serving as a support to other families hosting children.

Outreach Event Volunteer

Serve at an Orchard Hill outreach event (i.e. Trunk or Treat, Christmas outreach, Easter outreach, Arts Camp, etc.).

Outreach Event Planning Teams

Help vision and prepare for an Orchard Hill outreach event.

Orchard Hill Preschool and Child Care Center

Assist on the playground from 3:30 PM - 5:00 PM any day, Monday-Friday, or adopt a classroom for the year.

Neighborhood Outreach Team

Connect with our neighbors at community events or door to door in surrounding neighborhoods to share about Orchard Hill and the Lord.

Evangelism Team

Have a passion for sharing the gospel? Join this team that aims to keep evangelism at the heart of all OHC ministry.

Bus Ministry

Drive or ride on the bus on Sunday mornings to pick up and drop off families from the Orchard apartments and the motel so they can join in worship.

Mission Trip Teams

Share the good news of Jesus and serve in His name on one of our domestic disaster relief trips or an international trip!

WORSHIP MINISTRY

Using our gifts and talents to serve God and others.

Worship Choir

Use your gift of singing to help others worship with authenticity and passion. We sing the 4th Sunday of the month and practice the Wednesday evening prior to the week we sing.

Vocal Team

Rotating teams of talented vocalists lead the congregation in praise and worship. (Admission by application/audition)

Band

Experienced musicians who love to use their gifts in the praise band. Guitars, drums, keys, percussion, orchestral instruments and the like all join to together to create a worship atmosphere and accompany the congregation in Sunday services. Seasonal groups formed throughout the year as well!

Production

Create an environment for people to engage in worship by assisting in the execution of the production of the worship service. Technical & artistic skills needed!

Learn how to develop your leadership skills through music and worship arts by working closely with our Worship Arts Director and shadowing and learning from our OHC musicians.

YOUTH MINISTRY

Be a shepherd for a middle school small group. Shepherds care for, nourish, and lead their sheep. Likewise, a small group leader cares for the students in their small group and is responsible to lead each student spiritually in order to help them become committed disciples of Jesus Christ.

Greeter

Manage the registration table by checking in and/or registering students as they enter the doors. More importantly this role is responsible to be a smiling face that greets all the students as they come in the door!

Snack Coordinator

Create a snack sign up and recruit parents/church members to bring a tasty treat to youth group.

Drivers

Safe, responsible drivers are always needed for youth ministry. Drivers may volunteer to transport students who need a ride, drive students to an event, or drive for our summer trips.
