As many of you know, Orchard Hill has been walking alongside one of our long time congregation members, J acob Manyong, as he prayerfully attempts to bring his family to the United States from Africa. An update in the process: At the beginning of April (2023), Jacob got word that all the information required to set up an interview at the US Embassy overseas for his wife Sarah had been received. They are awaiting her interview date to be scheduled (hopefully very soon). Once the interview takes place, Sarah may receive a determination immediately or it may possibly take a bit of time. The paperwork for Blessing, Jacob's almost 3 year old daughter, is complete and she is a US Citizen and has her passport! Please note that until 2011, South Sudan records were not kept for births, weddings, and other important events that we in the United States are familiar with. Obtaining the needed documents for Jacob and his family required additional time. Finally, during the paperwork process for Emmanuel, a DNA test was performed, and it showed that he is not Jacob's biological son; Jacob is very heartbroken. Emmanuel will not be coming to the US, but Jacob continues to provide for him in South Sudan. As Jacob prepares for his families arrival, there are some things around the house he could use help with! If you would like to volunteer to help Jacob with these things, contact Pastor Laura.
