ARTS CAMP DONATIONS NEEDED

SUPPLIES:

Sign up on the forms at the Outreach table in the lobby. Place all donated supplies in the designated bin by the office.

- 80-90 count of 3ft. - 4ft. length fairy light strands (these come in multi-packs on amazon, ***MUST BE WARM WHITE COLOR***),
- 45 disposable bowls
- 45 popsicle sticks
- 50 - 60 empty glass food jars, NOT mason jars. (8oz. or bigger)
- 1 gallon(128 oz.) + 32oz. of mod podge (matte or gloss).
- Colored food dye (can be opened)
- Brown and Tan acrylic paint (large bottle)
- 20 tweezers
- 1 gallon *clear* glue (Amazon basics clear glue)
- 3 packs of 32oz. of faux craft moss in a bag (**not in a sheet/roll**)
- 500 Rubber hair bands (all shapes colors and sizes)
- 500 Bobby pins
- Fun hair pins, ties, ribbons, clips, bows, etc.
- 20 hand-held mirrors
- large bags of multi colored pony beads (best from Michael's Craft Stores or Amazon. **Do not use hobby lobby, the holes are too small**).
- 150 Split rings for key chains
- Acrylic paint (variety of colors)
- 40 empty toilet paper/paper towel rolls
- 40 coffee filters
- 40 pipe cleaners
- 15 kitchen sponges
- large bulletin board paper
